Key Highlights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iPad Workshops</li> </ul> <p>On each first Friday of the month, the library offers an iPad workshop during which patrons may borrow an iPad. Registration is required via walk-in or calls to Helpdesk.</p>
Collection Highlights	<p><b>Adults' and Young People's Collection:</b></p> <p>The Adults' and Young People's Collection is found on Level Two. The collection consists of popular subjects such as Travel, Business, Health and Cookery. The fiction collection, magazines, newspapers and AV materials can also be found at this level.</p> <p>There is also a comics corner specially dedicated to the youths in the Young People's Collection at Level Two.</p> <p><b>Children's Collection:</b></p> <p>The Children's Collection is found on Level One and has materials suitable for children from the ages of 0 to 12. The collection includes children's magazines, books for babies, picture books for pre-schoolers, as well as stories, fairy tales and informational books for older children.</p>

Library History	<p>Bukit Merah Public Library was officially opened on 28 December 1982 by Mr Lim Chee Onn, then Member of Parliament and Minister Without Portfolio.</p> <p>The library shut its doors for eight months from 28 June 2004 for major refurbishment and renovation works and reopened on 25 February 2005.</p> <p>The opening ceremony was officiated by Associate Professor Koo Tsai Kee, then Senior Parliamentary Secretary, MINDEF and Ministry of Environment and Water Resources and MP of Tanjong Pagar GRC.</p>
Interesting Facts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bukit Merah Public Library was one of the first few libraries to offer audio-visual loan services.</li> <li>• Although the library has a range of programmes for the different age groups, it has a strong collection catered for senior citizens and offers programmes relevant for the age group.</li> </ul>
