2 Wear a mask and see a doctor promptly if you are unwell




3 Stay home and avoid crowded places if you have flu-like symptoms



Inside the library, I will whisper and keep my voice down I do not want to disturb other people I will walk in the library. I do not want to trip or hurt anyone if I run






I must be careful when I'm using library books or other library items

If I climb on the shelves, they may dislodge and books will fall off the shelves I do not want to hurt myself if I fall or when the books hit me






There will be plants like these all over the library. I shall not play with them or pull them


If I pull the plants, the plants will break

I will not run, jump or play on the escalator. I do not want to hurt myself or others. I shall not lean over the handrail too.




I must not stop or loiter at the landing area so that I do not obstruct other people


When using the escalator, I must follow these safety measures:



Do not stand near the sides of the escalator. Soft footwear may get stuck in between the gaps in the escalator.




Do not stand at the edge of escalator steps. You may lose your balance and fall. Stand within the yellow lines where marked.





I can go to Level 5 by taking the lift or staircase. I shall walk when using the stairs






This lift is meant for patrons with access needs. Please ask our staff for assistance if you need to use the lift.



I can listen to stories and play games on these computers










This is the Story Circle at level 5

I will find them all over the library I can use the them to search for books I want to read




These computers are called **multimedia stations**
