

# Library Etiquette & Safety Precautions







Inside the library, I will whisper and keep my voice down.

I do not want to disturb other people.


I will walk in the library. I do not want to trip or hurt anyone if I run.

### **Library Etiquette & Safety Precautions**










I must be careful when I'm using library books or other library items.

I cannot tear, fold or step on books because they will be damaged.

Everyone can enjoy the books only if they are <u>not</u> damaged!



# I must not climb on the bookshelves.

If I climb on the shelves, they may dislodge and books will fall off the shelves.

I do not want to hurt myself if I fall or when the books hit me.




There will be potted plants like these all over the library.

I shall not play with them or push them over.


If I push the plants, they may topple over and I may break the plant.

I do not want to fall and cut myself on the broken pot pieces.

### When using the escalator, I must follow these safety measures:



I shall hold on to the handrail and stand still when going up or down using the escalator



I will not run, jump or play on the escalator. I do not want to hurt myself or others. I shall not lean over the handrail too.



I must not stop or loiter at the landing area so that I do not obstruct other people

I will not leave any drawers open in case other people walk into or trip over them.



## I will enter through the gates.






If I need help, I will go to this information point at level 1.

I can come here to buy food and drinks when I am hungry or thirsty.










This sign shows me the wheelchair accessible cubicle.

On **level 2**, I can find and read books written in mother tongue languages, like Chinese, Malay and Tamil. I can find books about Singapore in Tamil on this floor too.








On **level 3**, I can find and read English books for adults, including comics.






I can also find books about Singapore in English, Malay and Chinese on level 3.

This is the **MakeIT space** on level 3. I can create small, 3D-printed objects here!




I can charge my mobile phone or tablet at this **Quick Charge station** on level 3.





On **level 4**, I can find and read magazines and books for children in English, Malay, Chinese and Tamil.





On level 4 I can borrow audiovisual materials for children to listen or watch at home.

I can listen to stories and play games on these computers.



I can find and read English books for teenagers and young adults on level 4.



I will see many other children with their families here on level 4.

I can sit and read under this large tree.

I will remove my shoes first before I sit.

I can enter the huts to sit and read.

One person can enter this hut at one time.

If there is someone inside the hut, I can ask a library staff for help.



## These computers are called **multimedia stations**.

I can find them on levels 1, 2, 3 or 4.

I can use the computers to do many things!

For example, I can read eNewspapers, eMagazines, print documents or browse the internet.





I can pay for printing using these payment modes

## This is a **printing station**.

I can find this near the multimedia stations on levels 2, 3 and 4.

I can come here to print documents and pay for printing.

Before printing, I will use the multimedia station to submit the document to print.

Before leaving, I can borrow them at these **borrowing stations** at levels 1 or 4!



I can also borrow or reserve books using the **NLB Mobile app**!



I can scan this QR code to download the app using Google Play or Apple App Store.



After I borrow a book, I can check the due date on my NLB Mobile app.

The page will look like this.

The **due date** for me to return the book I borrowed will be written here.



I will put the books that I don't want to borrow on this trolley.


I will put the books here so that the library staff can put the books back to the correct shelves





If a book is unavailable, I can reserve it.

I will come here another day to collect my reserved books from the **Reservation Lockers**.



This is the **Bookdrop**.

I must return my borrowed books here by the due date.



Now I know where to go in the library.

I also know what I can find and do at each level.

If I want to read and listen to stories, I can always come back to visit the library!
