KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Verging All Teens (V.A.T.)

A dedicated teens' space created for teens by teens, to inspire teens. It also houses open-mic gigs and performances to showcase young talents to their peers.

Early Literacy Library

The first library in Singapore to house an Early Literacy Library. This library caters to two age groups: under 3-year-olds and 4- to 6-year-olds. The collection focuses on key areas vital to children's learning and development. The books and audio-visual materials are available in the four official languages.

MakelT at Libraries

Formerly known as PIXEL Labs@NLB, the renamed MakeIT at Libraries is a free-for-public makerspace that offers NLB library members a making and crafting workspace, as well as access to digital making equipment such as 3D printers and microcontrollers. COLLECTION HIGHLIGHTS

Jurong Library has an extensive collection and targets those who have more specialized information needs. It has a collection size of about 300,000 volumes.

- Young People Collection: The Teens Library occupies approximately 1,200 square
 meters on the fourth level and houses a curated collection catering to teenagers. The
 collection features a wide range of fiction and non-fiction titles in English and Chinese,
 including popular reads, contemporary young adult literature, and resources that
 support learning and personal development.
- Early Literacy Library: Jurong Library is also the first library in Singapore to house the Early Literacy Library located at the basement. This library houses a collection of about 71,000 books which caters to two age groups: under 3 years and 4 to 6 years. The collection focuses on five key areas playing, talking, singing, reading and writing which are vital to children's learning and development. The collection for children below 3 years old is categorised into the themes of Sense & Sensation, Concepts, Languages, Poetry & Rhymes and Emergent Reader. The books and audio-visual materials are available in the four official languages.

LIBRARY HISTORY

Jurong Library was officially opened on 4 Jun 2004 by Mr. Tharman Shanmugaratnam, then Acting Minister for Education. The library was originally opened on 1 August 1988 as Jurong East Community Library by Mr. Ho Kah Leong, then Senior Parliamentary Secretary (Communications & Information) and then Member of Parliament for Jurong Constituency. After the completion of its refurbishment in 2004, it re-opened as a regional library.

INTERESTING FACTS

Jurong Library is the first public library in Singapore with a skylight incorporated into its structure. It is also the first to use a unique energy saving reflector light technology in Singapore. This technology works by using high reflecting aluminum mirrors, saving up to fifty percent of energy used in conventional lighting.
