


Clash of Claws

In Korean folklore, cats were associated with bad luck, which might explain why the cat faced a bit of trouble in this tale. Today, cats are beloved pets of many and the city of Goyang in South Korea even has a cat mascot!



Giraffe's Gigantic Gulp

Get ready for a puppet storytelling adventure featuring the giraffe from the *Little Red Tortoise*!

Storytelling Tip

As you play out the story, wiggle the giraffe whenever it speaks!

Fun Fact

In South Africa, puppets have been an important part of storytelling for a long time. Now, you can see them on TV and at puppet festivals with performers from different places!

1. Pop out the giraffe from the sheet.
2. Make loops by using the slits at the ends of the tabs.
3. Fold the giraffe forwards, following the line in the middle of its mouth.
4. Fold back the top and bottom of the giraffe, following the lines at the top and bottom of its mouth.
5. Slip your fingers through the loops to control the giraffe's mouth movements. Your finger puppet is now ready for storytelling!
