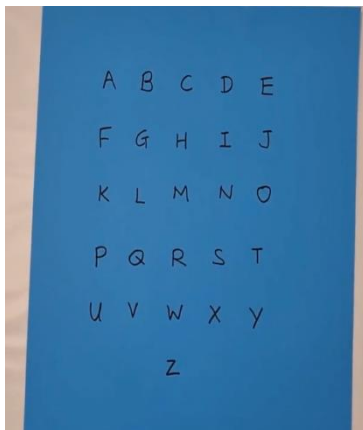


# Holiday Specials: Spot the Rhyming Words

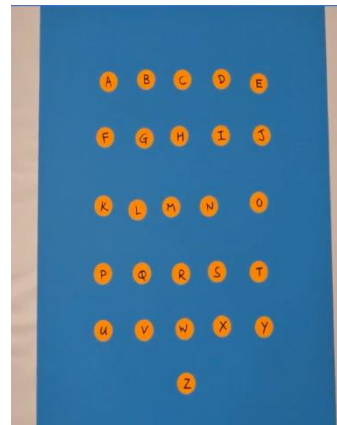
## Materials needed:

- 1 kitchen paper roll
- 2 pieces of A4 size colored paper
- Marker
- A pair of scissors
- Double-sided tape
- Dot stickers (optional)

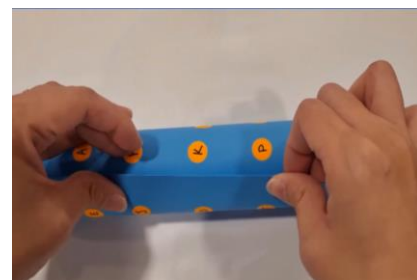
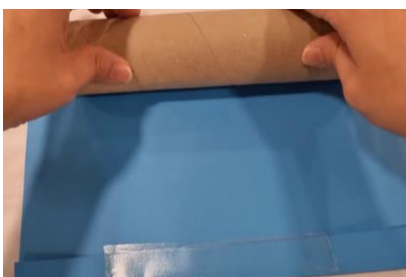
1. Use the marker to write all 26 letters of the alphabet on a piece of A4 paper or write the letters on dot stickers and paste them on a piece of A4 paper.

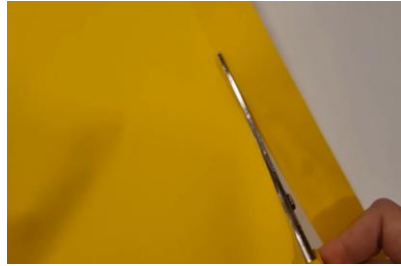
2. Wrap the paper around the kitchen paper roll and secure it with double-sided tape.



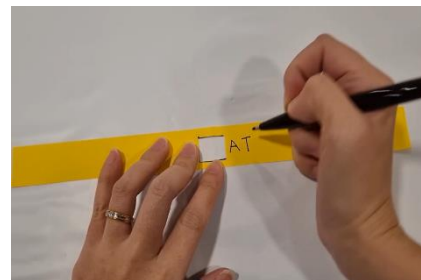
3. Push the excess paper, at both sides, inwards into the kitchen paper roll.



- Cut a strip of paper from the second piece of A4 paper. Do ensure it is long enough to go one round around the kitchen paper roll.



- Cut a square on the strip of paper and write the ending sound "AT" after the square. (Note: Parents, do assist your child if they need help with cutting.)



- Wrap the strip of paper around the kitchen paper roll and secure with double-sided tape.



- Rotate the strip of paper around the kitchen paper roll, to fit the different letters into the square. How many valid rhyming words can you find?



8. You may also create different strips of paper with other ending sounds, such as “AP” or “AN”.
