
Holiday Specials: Tiger Paper Hand Puppet

Materials needed:


- A4 size orange construction paper
- White, pink, orange and red paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Black marker
- 1. Turn the A4 size orange construction paper so that the long side is facing you. Fold the bottom side up so that the fold is slightly wider than your hand.



2. Fold down the top side, and glue it down firmly.



3. Flip the paper over and fold it so that the right edge touches the left.






4. Fold the top half of the paper so that the left edge touches the right. Flip the paper over and do the same.




5. Turn up the right side of the paper, and you will see two pockets. Put your thumb into one and your other fingers into the other. And here is your hand puppet!




6. Now for the ears of the tiger. Place the cap of your glue stick along the bottom of the pink paper, and use the black marker to trace two semi-circles. Then, cut them out. (Note: Parents, do assist your child if they need help with cutting.)




7. Stick the pink semi-circles onto the orange paper and cut these out, leaving a small margin around the pink semi-circles.



8. Stick the ears face up inside the top layer of the top pocket of the puppet.





9. Next, trace circles on the white paper using the glue stick cap.




10. Draw pupils to form the eyes of the tiger. Then, cut them out. (Note: Parents, do assist your child if they need help with cutting.)




11. Place the eyes side by side at the bottom of the paper and trace out a wider semi-circle to form the tiger's mouth.







12. Draw a triangle for its nose and connect the bottom to the edge of the mouth.



13. Colour the nose black. Then, draw dots for whiskers. Cut this out. (Note: Parents, do assist your child if they need help with cutting.)



14. Then, glue these parts onto the puppet.




15. Now for the stripes. Draw three triangles on the top, left and right edge of the puppet, pointing in, and colour them in.




16. Lastly, draw the tiger's tongue on the red paper. Measure the height and width of two glue stick caps from the bottom of the paper and trace the outer edges to form the tongue.





17. Cut it out and stick it to the bottom of the puppet's mouth. (Note: Parents, do assist your child if they need help with cutting.)



18. And there you have it! Your very own tiger paper hand puppet.
