

Holiday Specials: Cat Collage

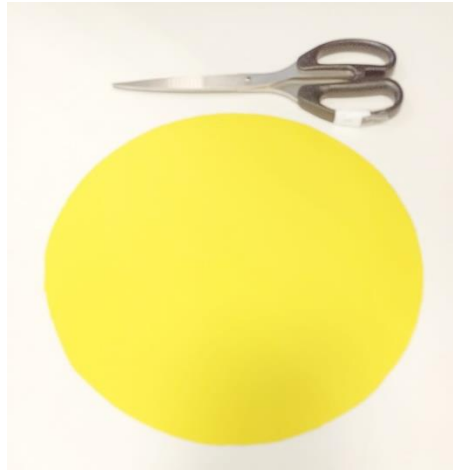
Materials Needed:

- Scissors
- Construction Paper of any preferred colours
- Pencil
- Glue
- Ruler
- Markers
- Yarn, Ribbons or Glitter Glue (Optional)

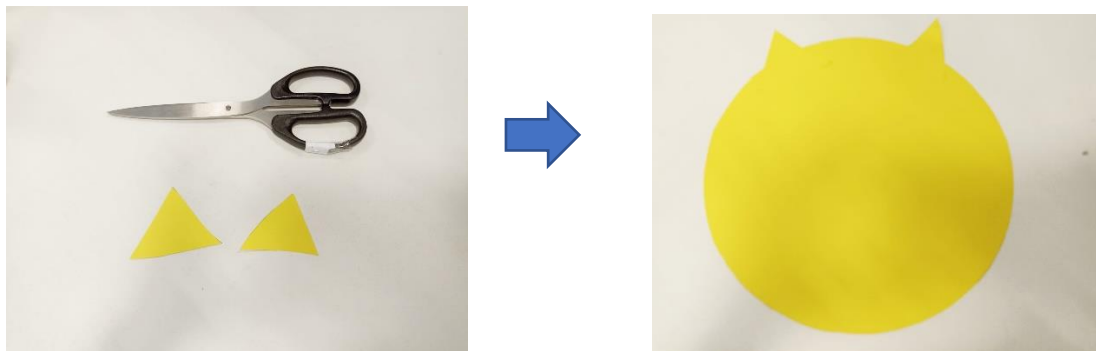


1. Start by selecting a piece of construction paper in your favourite colour. This will be the cat's head. Measure out a circle of 15cm in diameter and cut it out. You can use anything that is circle to ensure a perfect circle. A paper plate is a very handy tool for this!

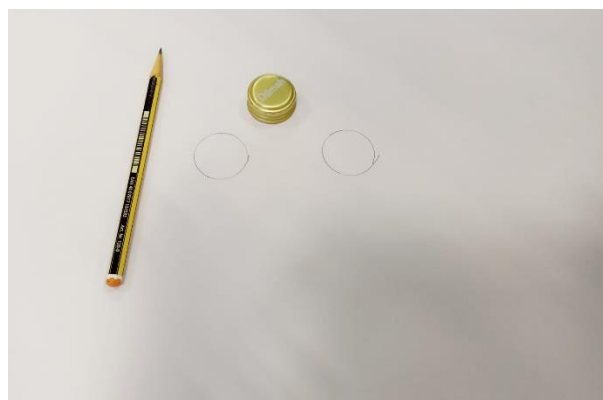


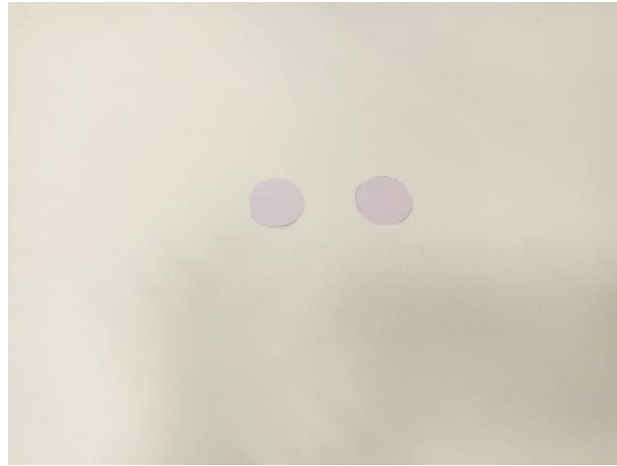


2. Using the same piece of construction paper, cut out two triangles. They can be as big or small as you want them to. Paste these on the top of the big circle.



3. Take another piece of construction paper, in a different colour and cut out two smaller circles. You can use a bottle cap to help with the measuring and accuracy. These will be the cat's eyes.





4. After pasting the eyes on, cut out a small triangle from another piece of construction paper and paste it just below the two eyes, in the middle of the circle.



5. Next, draw on the cat's mouth with a marker. You can design the mouth in any way you want. You can follow the example below.



6. Afterwards, draw in some curved lines with the marker for the whiskers and fill in the eyes.



7. Time to be creative! Add patterns to your cat or glue on other materials you have lying around. This is a great opportunity to unleash your full creativity and recycle the leftover bits of paper or some yarn, string, or ribbon.

With some yarn, you can make a mane for a lion. Rawr!
